

## Rabbit antibody to SNIP

**ID Tag** Rb3243-120518-WS

Unit size 500 ug

Immunogen A synthetic peptide from human SNIP conjugated to blue carrier protein was used as the antigen.

The peptide is homologous in rat and mouse.

**Conjugate** Unconjugated antibody

Also known p130 Cas associated protein, p140 Cap, SNAP 25 interacting protein, P140

**Host** NZ white rabbit

**Purity** lgG

Clonality Polyclonal Isotype Polyclonal, IgG

Applications IHC, WB. A concentration of 10-50 µg/ml is recommended. The optimal concentration should be

determined by the end user. Not yet tested in other applications.

**Specificity** Specific for SNIP.

Spcs X-react. Rat, mouse, human, marmoset. Other species not yet tested.

Format Lyophilised

Reconstitution Reconstitute in 500 ul of sterile water. Centrifuge to remove any insoluble material.

Storage Maintain the lyophilised/reconstituted antibodies frozen at -20C for long term storage and


refrigerated at 2-8C for a shorter term. When reconstituting, glycerol (1:1) may be added for an

additional stability. Avoid freeze and thaw cycles.

**Expiry Date** 12 months after reconstitution

**Shipping** This item will be shipped to you at ambient temperature in a lyophilised form.

**Limitation** For research use only



IHC-P on paraffin sections of rat brain.

The animal was perfused using Autoperfuser at a pressure of 130 mmHg with 300 ml 4% FA being processed for paraffin embedding. HIER: Tris-EDTA, pH 9 for 20 min using Thermo PT Module.

Blocking: 0.2% LFDM in TBST filtered thru 0.2 µm.

Detection was done using Novolink HRP polymer from Leica following manufacturers instructions; DAB chromogen: Candela DAB chromogen from Osenses.

Primary antibody: dilution 1: 500, incubated 30 min at RT using Autostainer.

Sections were counterstained with Harris Hematoxylin.
